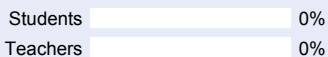

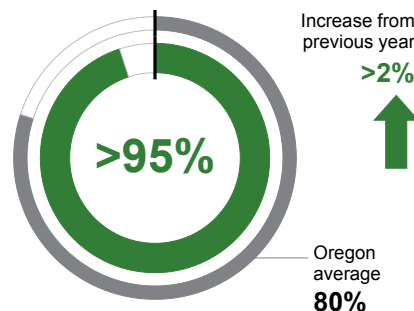

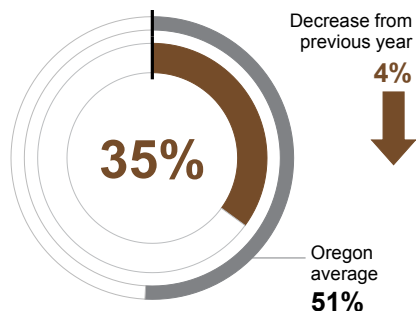

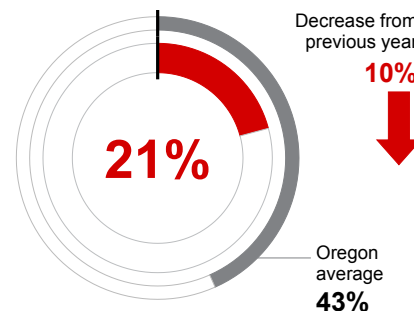

MATHEMATICS

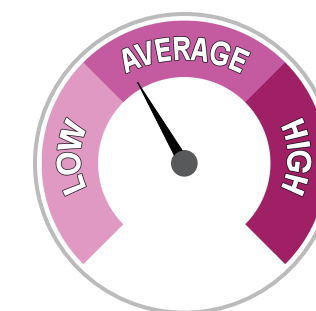
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

School Goals

At Cairo Elementary, we believe in educating the whole child. We place an emphasis on both academics and positive behavior traits. We also have a strong emphasis on the connection of attendance to school success. Through our Attention 2 Attendance program, we work with students and parents to inform them of the importance of regular attendance. Due to this work, we have seen the attendance rate for our school increase over the last year.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

At Cairo Elementary, we strive to ensure all students and their families feel welcome. We have multiple bilingual staff members including front office staff. All communication sent home through mail, phone, text, and hand delivered notes is translated. We provide interpreters at parent/teacher conferences, IEP meetings, and other school meetings.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

At Cairo Elementary we offer several Family Events including Title One Night, Back-To-School Open House, English Language Development, Math, Reading, and STEM Family Nights throughout the year. We partner with Oregon State University Extension, Family and Community Health 4-H Youth Development, and Frontier STEM Hub, Malheur ESD to support our teachers, students and families. Cairo's PTO is very involved in our school and supports our Family Nights and educational field trips to provide additional learning opportunities for our students. Communication is provided through School Newsletters, phone calls, text messaging and Facebook.
